<u>Registration</u> begins June 3 at 9 am. Registration is online only. If a class is filled, you may place your name on the waitlist on the website. Waitlist does not carry over to future sessions. You are only guaranteed a space once payment is received. <u>Students with class credit or a gift certificate should call the office in advance of the registration date to make sure you were given a discount code</u> so that you may register using your credit or gift certificate. Payment is by credit card, online.

Additional Class Use and End of Class time

Classes include additional weekly work time to practice your skills. Adult classes (excluding Jewelry and Fused Glass workshops) meeting 2 hours weekly include an additional 6 hours per week; classes meeting 2.5 hours weekly include an additional 7.5 hours per week. The glaze room is reserved for students only during classes for the last half of the class term. So, for example, during the last 5 weeks of each 10-week class, the glaze room is reserved for student use only during the class. Students may also make appointments to reserve the glaze room. Go to the website to make a glaze room appointment. Students may use the glaze room up to 3 hours per week and are allowed up to 4 cubic feet of firing space per month. STUDENT FIRINGS ARE LIMITED TO PIECES MADE IN CLASS ONLY. Additional firings will be charged at the outside firing rates. Plan wet work prior to last week of class to allow time for bisque and glazing. There is a one-week grace period after class has ended to complete and pick up work.

Covid-19

Please remain home when not feeling well. Masks are not required.

Waiver of Liability Forms

<u>Waiver Forms</u> serve as your registration and must be filled out by all students. It is not necessary to fill out another waiver form if you have previously taken a class in the past two years. Waiver forms are online. Please print out, sign, and bring to first class.

Summer Session Refund Policy

If the Fire Arts Center cancels a class, you will receive a full refund. If the student chooses to withdraw from a class, the refund policy is as follows:

A \$20 administration fee will be deducted from all cancellations. In addition, cancellations requested prior to Saturday June 15, 2024, will receive 100% refund, less the \$20 fee, cancellations received prior to Wednesday June 19, 2024, will receive 50% refund, less the \$20 fee. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN AFTER JUNE 20, 2024.

There are NO REFUNDS once class has begun. The Fire Arts Center does not prorate for missed classes due to vacations, schedule conflicts, etc.

Hours vary on weekends and holidays but generally we are open every day.
